To gain access to e-mail and the Internet, all students under the age of 18 must obtain parental permission and must sign and return the attached form to his/her campus office. Students 18 and over may sign their own forms.

Access to e-mail and the Internet will enable students to explore thousands of libraries, databases, and bulletin boards while exchanging messages with Internet users throughout the world. Families should be warned that some material accessible via the Internet may contain items that are illegal, defamatory, inaccurate or potentially offensive to some people. Booker ISD has contracted with an Internet filtering company that helps monitor such sites. While our intent is to make Internet access available to further educational goals and objectives, students may find ways to access other materials as well. We believe that the benefits to students from access to the Internet, in the form of information resources and opportunities for collaboration, exceed any disadvantages. But ultimately, parents and guardians of minors are responsible for setting and conveying the standards that their children should follow when using media and information sources.

Each parent permission form must be returned for each child at enrollment. Without a signed form, your child will not be given access to the BISD network or the Internet.
